

Deposit and Student Responsibility Form

I hereby give permission for my son/daughter, _____, to attend National FFA Convention. Should my son/daughter violate school policy regarding student behavior within the Laurel-Concord Public Schools Student Handbook or the FFA Code of Conduct Form signed at the beginning of the year, the school administration and I will be notified. I, the parent/guardian, will then make arrangements for the immediate return of my child incurring all costs of transportation.

I also understand that **the money deposited for the student is non-refundable. The deposit will be forfeited to the Chapter to cover the cost of the bus and hotel reservation should my child decide not to attend after paying (this includes the student choosing to participate in another school function such as football or volleyball playoffs) or if he/she is unable to go due to responsibilities that he/she failed to meet.** To be eligible to attend, the student must:

- 1) *maintaining proper grades*
- 2) *complete all class work that will be missed ahead of time and be signed out by the all teachers*
- 3) *fill out all of the proper medical release forms and code of conduct forms and return them with the appropriate signatures to Ms. Meyer before leaving for convention.*
- 4) *present to the Laurel-Concord FFA Alumni at the November meeting following convention on their experience*
- 5) *write a thank you note to the FFA Alumni for paying an additional \$150 for the student's bus and hotel expenses*
